



University costs and how to pay for them



Different amounts depending on your situation

- Where you're from
- Where you're studying- London students are entitled to the higher London rate of maintenance loan
- Whether you will be living at home whilst you study
- Partly based on household income
 Paid directly to you three times a year
 (Sept, Jan & April).

Covers the full cost of the tuition fee

Paid directly by the Student Loan Company to the university.

Not based on household income

– everyone gets the same
amount

Applying for Student Loans



- Apply online
- Applications open around March so start early
- You don't need a confirmed place at university
- You can change details later on
- Apply for tuition fee loan, maintenance loan, or both



How do repayments work?





You do not start repaying your student loan until the April after you graduate



Your repayments are based on how much you earn and come out of your pay cheque like a tax



After 40 years any remaining debt is wiped

Threshold



£25,000 per year

£2083 a month

£481 a week

9%

If your income drops below this at any time- you stop making repayments


