Subject: Research Study: The SnapBack Resilience Programme for school-aged children transitioning to secondary school (Year 7)

We know that many children thrive when they start secondary school, but for some, it can be a challenging time. To support all children's wellbeing, the School Health Team at Your Healthcare provide the 'Snapback Resilience Programme' for Year 7 pupils via their school. This programme is currently being evaluated and we would like to **invite you and your child (or the child you have parental responsibility for) to participate in the research study.**

Year 7 students will either start the Snapback Resilience Programme in October 2022 or February 2023. If you and the child agree to participate, you will both be asked to complete three 5-minute questionnaires. You can choose to complete the questionnaires online or by post.
