Autumn Update from the Head of Year 11

We would like to congratulate Year 11 students on their positive start to the autumn term and provide a reminder of the assessment dates for this year along with the support on offer to our students. The first assessment fortnight is taking place from Monday 2 October 2023 until Friday 13 October 2023 and will be a valuable opportunity for Year 11 students to consolidate their learning, for staff to provide feedback on their progress and to highlight areas for further development. Students have been informed of when their class assessments are and which topics they should be revising via the AF1 information channel on Microsoft Teams.

Assessment Overview

Below is a provisional outline of our internal assessment dates for Year 11. There will be more detailed information to follow in due course.

Assessment fortnight 3 (CORE only) and Practical Week	18 March 2024 - 27 March 2024	 Students will complete assessments in English, Maths and Science only Students will complete practical components for their subjects

We want to ensure that we are continuing to offer lots of support to our Year 11 students over the course of this year and in the lead up to their final GCSE exams in the summer.

Monday 1:1 Support

On Mondays the Year 11 Form Tutors work with students on a 1:1 basis during tutorial. During this time, students are able to have meaningful discussions with their Form Tutor to identify areas for support, complete target setting activities and share any concerns or difficulties they are experiencing.



Enrichment, Independent Study and Intervention

Year 11 have a wide variety of enrichment opportunities available to them. We have dedicated revision/independent study time each week as part of the tutorial programme.

In addition to this there will be targeted subject intervention sessions running later in the year to further support students. More detailed information will be shared with you regarding this closer to the time.

Workday Wednesdays

This is a voluntary independent study session, supervised by the Head of Year and subject teachers. The aim of this is to give students a quiet, purposeful environment to complete independent study. It has proven popular with students during mock exams in Year 10 and we had a large turn out each week. This will continue to run every Wednesday after school from 3.10pm-4.00pm in the library, starting from Wednesday 27 September 2023.

GCSE Pod

All Year 11 students have access to GCSE pod which is an excellent online revision resource. The resource is subject specific and linked to the exam specification for each subject. It contains short, informative summary 'pods' and opportunities to test their knowledge with immediate feedback on their performance. Students may access this through www.gcsepod.com and may log in using their school login details.
