The Young Reporter Scheme, working in partnership with Newsquest Media Group, run an exciting extra-curricular opportunity for students in years 10 to 13, allowing them to experience what it is like to work for a real live newspaper. It is a fantastic experience for them to put on their CVs and it can be run alongside Duke of Edinburgh (bronze and silver).

Newsquest is one of the largest news organisations in the UK and have a portfolio of more than 120 news brands and 29 magazines, online and in print. With an online audience of almost 40 million users, our content is read by a substantial proportion of the UK population. This unique scheme is structured as if students are working directly for the paper, as they are given deadlines to work to, topics to write about and every article is published on Newsquest's range of online newspapers.

Throughout the scheme, students can apply to cover some exciting events, interviews, theatre reviews, large attractions and other opportunities. In addition to this they can compete to have their work published on the Student Comet, which is our own student newspaper.

Thousands of students have taken advantage of this opportunity over many years and some of the students who have done it in the past, are now actively working in the media.
