

DEED OF VARIATION

The parties to this Deed are the **Secretary of State for Education** (“the Secretary of State”) and **Tolworth Girls’ School and Sixth Form**, (“the Academy Trust”) a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 07700838.

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Secretary of State and the Academy Trust entered into a funding agreement dated 11 July 2011 (“the Funding Agreement”) relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as **Tolworth Girls’ School and Sixth Form**.
- B. The Secretary of State and the Academy Trust have agreed to vary certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with this Deed.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

- 1. Any word or phrase used in this Deed shall, if that word or phrase is defined in the Funding Agreement, bear the meaning to it in the Funding Agreement.
- 2. The Secretary of State and the Academy Trust agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Deed.
- 3. Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

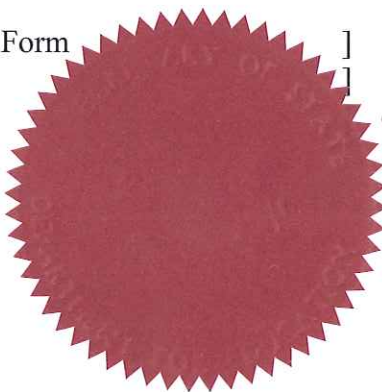
