Attendance & Punctuality

As we start the new academic year, we would like to remind you of the direct link between excellent attendance and high academic achievement. Our expectation is that students are in school and on time every day. This means arriving at school no later than 8.25am. Any student arriving after 8.25am will be issued with a same day, 30 minute detention. We ask for your support in ensuring your daughter leaves for school with enough time to navigate any potential traffic delays or public transport issues.

Uniform and Standards

At Tolworth Girls' School & Sixth Form we are proud of our school community and have high expectations for student uniform and conduct. We believe that this is one aspect of creating a culture of high expectations and high achievement. All students are expected to be in full Tolworth Girls' School uniform every day. If a student arrives at the school in the incorrect uniform, we will support students in the following ways to meet our expectations:

- offer items to borrow (if available)
- ask them to go home and change (in agreement with parents/carers)
- ask them to work in isolation until the correct uniform is delivered to the school by parents/carers

Repeated incidents of incorrect uniform will result in a detention, as per our school policy. I would like to draw your attention to some specific aspects of our uniform expectations below:

- Hair this may not be dyed a colour which is not a natural colour. This also applies to any
 extensions
- Jewellery the only permitted jewellery is a pair of studs. Facial and body piercings are not permitted. Students should not wear rings, bracelets or necklaces
- Uniform hoodies are not part of uniform and should not be worn. All students should wear their school blazer when travelling around the school site. Blazers must not be carried
- School shoes these should be black leather school shoes. Students are not permitted to wear trainers, canvas shoes or boots
- Mobile phones and technology a reminder that we operate a "not seen or heard" policy regarding mobile phones and other items of technology, including headphones. This includes break or lunchtime. Any phone seen or heard will be confiscated and the appropriate sanction will be issued
